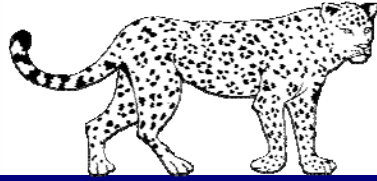

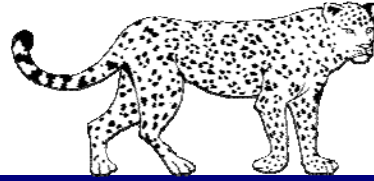


LEOPRD GOALS

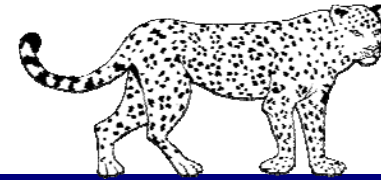

LEOPRD Membership

- Active versus Associate
- How to Apply

Active Membership

- Restricted to the primary director, manager, supervisor, or lead of agency's planning and research function
- Includes voting privileges, right to hold office, and serve on executive board
- Only one active membership per agency
- Valid for a one-year period

Associate Membership

- Open to anyone with professional or academic interest in law enforcement planning and research
- No voting privileges and cannot hold office
- Valid for a one-year period



How to Apply

- Submit a written or electronic application to the Director of Membership for either Active or Associate Membership
 - For Active Membership, a letter of endorsement and verification of assignment from your agency's Chief Executive; a current organizational chart; and a job description must also be included
